TRAINING/ CLINICS/ SEMINARS/ COACHING

Most horse owners and riders instinctively know their horse's inherent strengths and weaknesses. Based on the time spent together alone, they are "experts" on this individual creature. But if problems arise, for example in riding, in handling, in the training process of the horse, its health or in connection with the equipment -they find it difficult to translate what they know instinctively into practical solutions or to convey their impressions to consulting specialists. Add to this a number of other, often overlapping factors and things may get very complicated very quickly.

Decades of experience with sensitive and somewhat special horses as well as further specific training, allow me now to holistically analyse horses both individually and in rider-horse partnerships.

In principle, I pick up each horse and each rider where he or she is currently at. For any progress to be made, the basics must be in place. Every teaching or solution concept must be preceded by an inventory and analysis process to determine which fine-tuning screw needs to be adjusted first.

The goal is to provide the rider with the knowledge and tools to better respond to his horse. The reward is enjoyment and health for both.
